Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

Ripley County Transit, Inc. posts Title VI notices on our agency's website, in public areas of our agency, in our board room, and on our buses and/or paratransit vehicles.

Ripley County Transit, Inc. operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

To obtain additional information about your rights under Title VI, contact Ripley County Transit, Inc.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by Ripley County Transit, Inc., you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with Ripley County Transit, Inc.:

2. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
3. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
