


Title VI Policy

Adopted by Ripley County Transit's Board of Directors

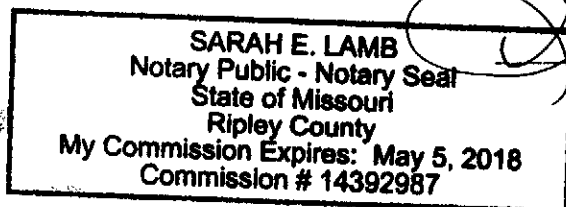


